In my library I have the Appleton's series of readers from the first to the fifth, used in the years 1888 to 1893. Teachers were Minnie Wolf, Hattie Baldwin, Bessie Baldwin, Anna Tait, Fannie Bierce and Mabel Marsh. This was back in the days before God was banished from the public schools. We sang Gospel hymns and had Bible readings. I recall that once we committed the 19th Psalm.

Appleton's Fourth Reader contains the entire Fifth and Sixth Chapters of Matthew, The Sermon on the Mount, and verses 14 to 30 from the 25th Chapter of Matthew, the Parable of the Talents.

The report received is most excellent for which the secretary deserves the highest commendation. My graduation in 1899 was so far away that in the list of members in attendance at the last meeting there are very few familiar surnames.

The mention of the passing of Grace Webb Burrell stirs memories of her graduation in 1891 when I was in the fourth grade. Her brother, William M. Webb, became principal. During High School days I bought from him the Caesar he had used, containing his signature.
