

1879 - OUR CENTENNIAL YEAR - 1979

The members of the Tallmadge High School Alumni Association met at the Tallmadge Buffet the evening of June 14, 1975, for the 96th Annual Meeting of the Tallmadge High School Alumni Association.

The arrangements committee chairman, E. Wallace Wood (1948), Polly Cook Price (1968), Betty Hazlett Colbert (1951), along with Thomas Gusbar (1946), Ellen Baker Hughes (1948), and Deborah Hughes (1972), provided table decorations and individual plaques with an American flag, commerating the "96th Tallmadge Alumni Banquet". The tables as always were appropriately decorated.

President, James Bliss (1951), called the meeting to order. The invocation was given by Boyd King (1950). Introduction was made of the head table along with members of all the committees responsible for the evenings meeting.

A motion was made by June King Marsh (1934) to increase the Tallmadge High School Alumni Association dues to \$2.00 per graduate starting in 1975. Seconded by Bob Crislip. Motion carried.

An ammendment to the dues increased was made by Frank Lawrence (1912) that those husband and wife graduates of Tallmadge High School pay \$2.00 per couple. Seconded by Natalie Olesky Rzewnicki (1948). Motion carried.

Dr. Pat E. Crisci, Superintendent of Tallmadge Schools suggested the next meeting be held in the Hexagon Room at the High School as it is air conditioned and a comfortable place to hold a meeting.

The 1976 meeting will be held Saturday, June 12, 1976, at Tallmadge High School.

A motion was made by Ellis W. King (1939) and seconded by Paul Wright (1950) to adjourn the meeting.

The meeting was closed with the singing of the Tallmadge High School Alma Mater, led by Paul Ragle (1938).
